Due to her guidance, she became the first Licensed Athletic Trainer in the State of Michigan. Additionally, she assisted in gaining third-party reimbursement for Athletic Training services in the state of Michigan. Ann also volunteered for the Athletic Training Profession as the first female MATS President (1999-2000), served as the Chair of the Michigan Board of Athletic Trainers (2007-2013), and GLATA Coordinator for Committee on Revenue (2009-2011).
